

## SB 3400-17 Service Bulletin

Date: August 20, 2009

Regarding: ST3400 with LED Backlight – display discoloration

Revision: A, Initial Release

#### Reason

Problems in the field with display discoloration.

## **Applicability**

Applies to all serial numbers ST3400-XXX with LED backlighting without MOD 4. (All units shipped prior to August 24, 2009).

## **Description**

There have been an increasing number of units returned to the factory for repair due to a discoloration (darkened area) in the center of the screen. This appears to occur on a random basis and some units are not affected. This problem has been traced to a combination of manufacturing tolerances and a plastic polarizer in the optical system which is not meeting its published specifications.

NOTE: This is a cosmetic condition, not a safety of flight condition.

A replacement glass polarizer has been designed which is not subject to this problem. This part can be factory retrofitted into any existing LED backlight unit.

### Compliance

On condition. The factory will perform this modification at any time during the service life of the affected unit. We recommend this repair be performed at a convenient time during normal airframe maintenance so it will not affect dispatch.
